What is the example?

The rare *Odyssey* artifact **Charmed Pendant** is one of a handful of cards that uses an example in its reminder text. The Pendant states that if you reveal a card that costs $3\text{ } \heartsuit \text{ } \spadesuit \text{ } \blacklozenge$, you add $\heartsuit \text{ } \spadesuit \text{ } \blacklozenge$ to your mana pool.

So what card is referred to in the example? Editing wanted to use a real, unique card when they were devising the example, so they chose the only card with a mana cost listed as $3\text{ } \heartsuit \text{ } \spadesuit \text{ } \blacklozenge$ -- **Spinal Embrace**.

One other old card has a functionally identical mana cost: *Legends'* **Princess Lucrezia**'s cost is written as $3\text{ } \heartsuit \text{ } \spadesuit \text{ } \blacklozenge$. Back then, costs didn't follow the same rules they do now. Currently, all multi-colored mana costs are ordered clockwise around the color wheel. In the [Oracle reference](#), **Princess Lucrezia**'s mana cost appears in the current correct form -- identical to **Spinal Embrace**'s $3\text{ } \heartsuit \text{ } \spadesuit \text{ } \blacklozenge$.
