Some quick rules on naming gleaned from Brady Dommermuth, our creative director:

- No anachronisms (guns, computers, etc.)
- No double-entendres
- No foreign words
- Names cannot start with "The" (The Rack, The Abyss, etc. Bad.)

Good enough. The creative guys can sort out the rest.

Refresher course: Mr. Babycakes is a 1GG 0/3 Elemental with the following text: "Whenever a player plays a spell, you may put a +1/+1 counter on CARDNAME. At the beginning of your upkeep, you may remove all +1/+1 counters from CARDNAME and distribute them among any number of creatures." His art description reads: "A humanoid elemental of moss supports itself with a hand against a dead tree. From where the elemental touches, it spreads wild regrowth." Name him appropriately.

You must be registered to submit a name, and you get to submit one per person. Submissions end midnight Sunday night. The top handful, as determined by our creative team, will be presented for a vote. I can't wait to see what you come up with.
