1. Art Description

These are the instructions given to the artist:

"Color: Green Location: Krosan Forest.
 Action: Show a beautiful female Spirit, somewhat ghostlike, in the Krosan Forest surrounded by large and vicious looking Krosan plants. She is walking past the plants unconcerned."

2. Sketch

This is the preliminary sketch submitted by Adam.



The internal Creative team here felt that Adam's first sketch was a little too dainty and delicate for what looked to be a powerful card, so they asked him to make some slight changes. His updated sketch satisfied all involved parties.
