### Card of the Day - mercredi 30 juin 2004



#### Urza's Bauble

*Ice Age* uncommon. The *Ice Age* cantrips originally granted the card immediately. This broke Urza's Bauble since all decks would have 4, so all cantrip card draws were given a delay in that set.

### Card of the Day - mardi 29 juin 2004



## Mana Crypt

Promotional card. Mana Crypt is the only card to ever be restricted or banned that didn't appear in any expansion or core set.

## Card of the Day - lundi 28 juin 2004



## Iron Star

*Alpha* uncommon. Despite their poor reputation, Iron Star and Wooden Sphere were both in constructed decks that made top 8 at Worlds 1995.

## Card of the Day - vendredi 25 juin 2004



## Decree of Justice

*Scourge* rare. One of the few cards that can produce angel tokens (like *Angelic Favor*), *Decree of Justice* is also remarkable for its ability to produce two different types of creature tokens.

## Card of the Day - jeudi 24 juin 2004



## Silver Seraph

*Judgment* rare. At 6/6, *Silver Seraph* is tied with *Akroma, Angel of Wrath* as largest angel in **Magic**. (Though if you had both in play with threshold, the *Akroma* would win the tie!)

## Card of the Day - mercredi 23 juin 2004



### Guiding Spirit

*Visions* rare.

Guiding Spirit has the distinction of being the smallest angel. (Angelic Curator and Angelic Page are spirits.)

## Card of the Day - mardi 22 juin 2004



### Lightning Angel

*Apocalypse* rare.

The only red angel in **Magic**, Lightning Angel is also the only tri-colored angel.

## Card of the Day - lundi 21 juin 2004



### Serra Angel

*Eighth Edition* rare.

Only one other angel has appeared in as many sets. (Fallen Angel, as long as you count the *Beatdown* box set.)

## Card of the Day - vendredi 18 juin 2004



### Engineered Explosives

*Fifth Dawn* rare.

The designers strongly wanted to have a sunburst "X" spell. This one, inspired by

Powder Keg, was the best of the bunch.

## Card of the Day - jeudi 17 juin 2004



### Skyreach Manta

*Fifth Dawn* common.

Called Blazon' Pterodactyl in design, the name refers to Emblazoned Golem, which inspired the sunburst mechanic.

## Card of the Day - mercredi 16 juin 2004



### Lunar Avenger

*Fifth Dawn* uncommon.

As the name hints, this card was inspired by Urza's Avenger from *Antiquities*.

### Card of the Day - mardi 15 juin 2004



### Baton of Courage

*Fifth Dawn* common.

The second "baton" printed in **Magic**, this is the only sunburst card that can be played at instant speed.

### Card of the Day - lundi 14 juin 2004



## Arcbound Wanderer

*Fifth Dawn* uncommon.

Modular was otherwise *Darksteel*-only, but the team included one card in *Fifth Dawn* since it interacts so well with sunburst.

## Card of the Day - vendredi 11 juin 2004



## Myr Moonvessel

*Darksteel* common.

Named "Uno-Eins" in playtesting, it means "one" in two languages. The name is similar to Su-Chi ("four" in two languages).

## Card of the Day - jeudi 10 juin 2004



## Myr Quadropod

*Fifth Dawn* common.

Though originally part of a cycle, only this card made it into the set. The original ability required blue mana.

## Card of the Day - mercredi 9 juin 2004



## Myr Matrix

*Darksteel* rare.

Called Gnome Maker in design (one guess why), the original version gave all Gnomes +1/+1 and made them indestructible.

## Card of the Day - mardi 8 juin 2004



### Myr Servitor

*Fifth Dawn* common.

Called Robo-Roach during playtesting, Myr Servitor was loosely inspired by Brood of Cockroaches.

## Card of the Day - lundi 7 juin 2004



### Coretapper

*Darksteel* uncommon.

Of all the Myr cards printed in *Mirrodin* Block, only Coretapper doesn't have the word

"Myr" in its name.

## Card of the Day - vendredi 4 juin 2004



### Yawgmoth's Will

*Urza's Saga* rare.

Many contend that this is the single most powerful Magic card ever printed.


## Card of the Day - jeudi 3 juin 2004





### Yawgmoth's Bargain

*Urza's Destiny* rare.

Intended as a fixed Necropotence, the original version turned in by the design team cost

### Card of the Day - mercredi 2 juin 2004



### Eye of Yawgmoth

*Nemesis* rare.

The effect from Eye of Yawgmoth was inspired by the *Tempest* card Altar of Dementia.

## Yawgmoth's Agenda

*Invasion* rare.

The first translation of this card's title to Japanese actually meant something along the lines of "Yawgmoth's Dayplanner."
