RULES

Note that *Gaze of Justice*'s flashback cost is the same as *Hand of Justice*'s mana cost. That beam is coming from a long way off—basically all the way from 1994!

Note also the big, nasty demon getting stricken in the art—John Avon used *Mirrodin*'s *Reiver Demon* as a model for it (but this is a Dominarian demon, so it lacks the metal elements of *Reiver Demon*).
